AMBER SPICER Amber presented a Life360 app showing the fire truck route and speed the day of the accident. Brian was at 25 MPH which is the posted speed limit for the road and Ron said he was going too fast for conditions. The truck did slow down to 13 MPH at some point. Amber showed photos on her phone of snow-covered road that day which was not a township road.

BRITTANY EVANS Brittany started off by asking Ron Krise if he cared about his fire company members? Ron said yes. She then asked why he attacked her if he cared. She said he did not even ask if she was okay. Ron said he didn't even know who she was that day.
