

BRADFORD TOWNSHIP BOARD OF SUPERVISORS REGULAR MEETING

May 5, 2026

- SWISHER CONTRACTING Swisher Contracting has submitted a request to DEP for release of reclamation bond on Hoopup Road.
- LIQUID FUEL PAYMENT Bradford Township received \$179,884.30 on March 2, 2026 in Liquid Fuels Tax Fund payment. This was \$1,218.47 less than the \$181,102.77 received last year.
- PA ONE CALL April has been designated as Pennsylvania 811 Safe Digging Month via proclamation as requested by PA One Call.
- ROAD CREW WAGES Moved to increase Josh Kephart’s wages that were tabled at the January 5th meeting to \$22.00 an hour and making it retroactive to the beginning of the year. This is a \$1.50 increase.
- LOAN FOR FIRE TRUCK Moved to approve securing a loan with First Commonwealth Bank of approximately \$100,000.00 for the balance that would be due on a Spartan S-180 to replace the 2015 Spartan that was totaled in an accident.

STANDING COMMITTEES

- HIGHWAY SAFETY COMMISSION Supervisor Denny Mulhollan said they have been busy cleaning ditches, replacing signs, tree trimming, cold patch, and working on Orchard Road grant project.
- EMERGENCY MANAGEMENT COORDINATOR Nothing to report for the month of April.

- TIM WALKER Tim said there were some potholes on Mutton Hollow Road that needed some cold patch.
- ART KEPHART Art asked about Shirey Spur Road and what was happening with it.
- BIGLER YMCA Members from the Bigler YMCA asked if there was a way Walker Road could be closed off on the SR 322 side. Supervisors said they would have to check with PennDOT.
