- GRAHAM SUBDIVISION Moved to approve the Final Subdivision Maps submitted for the Lawrence A. Graham and Scott A. Graham Subdivision
- GRAHAM SUBDIVISION Moved to approve signing Requests for Planning Waiver & Non-Building Declaration submitted for the Lawrence A. Graham and Scott A. Graham Subdivision.
- SHILOH ROAD SOLAR Moved to approve the Preliminary/Final Subdivision Maps submitted for the Shiloh Road Solar Project Land Development Plan contingent on the surveyor seal and all signatures.
