PENSION STATE AID

Bradford Township received \$16,667.64 on September 24th for the 2025 Commonwealth General Municipal Pension System State Aid allocation. The Township's MMO for 2025 is \$17,977.00

ASSOCIATION**

Bradford Township received \$16,021.95 on September 17th for the 2025 Commonwealth State aid allocation supporting the Volunteer Fire Relief Association. This is an increase of \$495.52 from last year. This money will be given to BJW Volunteer Fire Company Relief Association.
