2025 LIQUID FUEL	Bradford Township's estimated Liquid Fuels allocation for 2025 is \$177,888.04. This is an estimated decrease of \$1,886.40 from last year.
PENSION STATE AID	Bradford Township received \$16,518.93 on September 25th for the 2024 Commonwealth General Municipal Pension System State Aid allocation. The Township's MMO for 2024 is \$17,049.00.

ASSESSED REAL ESTATE	Bradford Township's estimated assessed real estate valuation for 2024 is \$25,883,361. This is an increase of \$51,637.00 from 2023.
