ASSESSED REAL ESTATE	Bradford Township’s estimated assessed real estate valuation for 2026 is \$51,460,582. This is a decrease of \$45,823. from 2025.						
2026 LIQUID FUEL	Bradford Township’s estimated Liquid Fuels allocation for 2026 is \$174,979.58. This is an estimated decrease of \$2,908.46 from last year.						
DGLVR GRANT CLOVER HILL ROAD	Bradford Township will be applying for a DGLVR Grant for Clover Hill Road Phase I.						
RESOLUTION 2025-13	Moved to adopting Resolution 2025-13 requesting a Local Share Account Statewide Grant from the Commonwealth Financing Authority for a used roller to replace the 2002 Bomag Roller.						
RESOLUTION 2025-14	Moved to adopt Resolution 2025-14 requesting a Local Share Account Statewide Grant from the Commonwealth Financing Authority for a CAT 416 Backhoe at a cost of \$125,153.00 to replace the 2006 John Deere Backhoe.

AUDITOR APPOINTMENT	Moved to appoint Kristen Petrosky to fill the auditor position with Kate Roberts' resignation. Kristen called the township office with interest in the position and sent in a resume.
RES COAL MINING	Bradford Township received notification from DEP on RES Coal Mining Permit Revision to include Module 28 for blasting. The site is located at the top of the hill on the left between Long Run Road and Roaring Run Road.
POLLING PRECINCTS	The Supervisors met with the County Commissioners on Friday, October 24 in regards to polling precincts. The Commissioners said they would leave Bradford Township's polling precincts alone for now but people need to step up to help on election days or there may not be a choice but to combine due to lack of interest to help on election days.
