ASSESSED REAL ESTATE

Bradford Township's estimated assessed real estate valuation for 2026 is \$51,460,582. This is a decrease of \$45,823. from 2025.

2026 LIQUID FUEL

Bradford Township's estimated Liquid Fuels allocation for 2026 is \$174,979.58. This is an estimated decrease of \$2,908.46 from last year.

The Commissioners said they would leave Bradford Township's polling precincts alone for now but people need to step up to help on election days or there may not be a choice but to combine due to lack of interest to help on election days.
